

**CITY OF WHITE SALMON
ORDINANCE 2022-09-1112**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WSMC 2.32 MAYOR AND COUNCIL SALARIES

WHEREAS, the city council has adopted White Salmon Municipal Code section 2.32 Mayor and Council Salaries; and

WHEREAS, the city council has determined that amendments to White Salmon Municipal Code Section 2.32 are necessary; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. White Salmon Municipal Code Section 2.32 Mayor and Council Salaries, is hereby amended as follows:

2.32.010 Salary schedule established.

A. The mayor shall receive a salary of ~~six hundred fifty-five~~ **two thousand** dollars per month.

B. Each member of the city council shall receive a salary of ~~eighty-three dollars per meeting, not to exceed one hundred sixty-six dollars~~ **two-hundred twenty-five dollars** per month.

C. Elected officials will receive compensation of fifteen dollars per hour up to one hundred twenty dollars per day of documented training attended/received in addition to travel expenses allowed by the city's travel policy.

2.32.020 Warrants for payment of salaries.

The city clerk-treasurer is authorized to issue the necessary vouchers and warrants for the payment of such salaries as described in Section 2.32.010 from the current expense fund of the city.

SECTION 2 – SEVERABILITY: If any section, sentence, or phrase of this Chapter is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence or phrase of this Chapter.

SECTION 3 – EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect five days following the date of its publication by summary.


